2010 AAS Mandarin and Art Spring Workshop (For children entering Kindergarten through 3rd grade)

Spring is coming soon and it is the time to register for AAS Mandarin and Art Spring Workshop, which is conveniently located in San Francisco.

AAS Mandarin and Art Spring Workshop is designed for children entering Kindergarten through 3rd grade. This program will give them a unique opportunity to learn and improve their language skills in Mandarin, while deepening their knowledge of Chinese culture and art through age appropriate play-based classes and activities in Mandarin.

The 5 days workshop **begins March 29 and ends April 2**. The basic program is from **9 am to 3 pm with an extended day option that lasts until 6pm**. The students participate in classes conducted in Mandarin that include such culturally rich activities as drawing, Chinese brush painting, playing the *yaogu* (the Chinese waist drum), Chinese folk songs and poetry. Field trips will be arranged for landscape drawing during the camp. All sessions, including the extended care, will be conducted in Mandarin.

The Mandarin and Art Spring Workshop is a small-sized workshop with a maximum of 15 students. Each student will receive personalized treatment provided with love and care. The camp's goal is to teach the children basic Mandarin communication skills while they are having fun with a variety of hands-on activities and games. The Confucius Institute at San Francisco State University will support AAS with a Mandarin teacher for this year of our Spring Workshop.
